

## Planning Checklist: Three Weeks until Moving Day

More than 14 days before moving

<ul> <li>O Get boxes and moving supplies.</li> <li>O Take unwanted items to charity and/or dump.</li> <li>O Dispose of household chemicals properly (old paint, caustic cleaners, etc.). Take these to the local Toxic Waste Centre.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Arrange phone service at your new home.</li> <li>Set up mail-forward with Canada Post.</li> <li>Arrange the return of any cable TV equipment.</li> </ul>
Complete necessary change of address forms:  O Drivers' license, Health cards, Insurance O Employer, Doctor, Dentist O Magazine subscriptions and other mailings O Memberships, insurance O Bank accounts, credit cards, and tax office (Canada Customs and Revenue Agency)	If necessary, do the following:  Make travel arrangements and reservations.  Arrange transfer of car insurance & license plates.  Notify kids' schools, transfer records.  Register at new school.  Get copies of medical and dental records; if you have pets, get copies of veterinary records.
O Return borrowed items. O Retrieve loaned items O Arrange for major applicances to be moved.	<ul><li>O Arrange connection of utilities at new place.</li><li>O Arrange disconnection of utilities at old place.</li><li>O Dispose of all flammable materials.</li></ul>
<ul> <li>2 to 7 days before moving</li> <li>O Determine what you can bring with you if travelling by car, plane, train, or bus.</li> <li>O Prepare "installed items" that you're bringing (TV antenna or shelves*).</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Pack a suitcase with the clothes and toiletries that you'll need the first day in your new home.</li> <li>Pack a special box with other essentials you'll need for the first few days and marks this box "Do Not Move".</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>The day before moving</li> <li>O Take down curtains and curtain rods.</li> <li>O Empty, defrost and clean refrigerator; clean the stove.</li> </ul>	O Pack your personal belongings, except your alarm clock, necessary clothes, jewellry and bedding
<ul> <li>Moving day</li> <li>Keep paperwork accessible.</li> <li>Strip and dismantle beds.</li> <li>Final walk-through: check all closets and cabinets</li> <li>If using a moving company, walk about with supervisor and sign inventory forms.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Collect all keys; keep them in a safe place.</li> <li>Clean premises that you are leaving, inspect with the landlord.</li> <li>If using a moving company, confirm the new address and delivery time with the driver.</li> <li>Know how to reach your new landlord or superintendent.</li> </ul>
Note: Ensure your lease permits the items that you plan to install screwed into walls or TV antennas	in a new place. Some leases may not permit the installation of shelving

Be sure to give proper notice; see the Provincial Fact Sheets for information on the notice required.
